- Class 1a Yeld mare or Gelding 4 years or over.
- Class 1b Gelding 4 years or over
- Class 2 Filly or Gelding 3 years old
- Class 3a Filly or Gelding 2 years old
- Class 3b Filly or Gelding 1 year old
Classes 3a & 3b may be combined if there are insufficient entries in either class.
- Class 4 Best Mare with Foal at Foot
- Class 5 Best Foal
- Class 6 Best Ridden Highland Pony 14.0hh and over
- Class 7 Best Ridden Highland Pony under 14.0hh
- Class 8 Best Team of Two or Three Highland Ponies in-hand or ridden
- Class 9 Traditional Working Highland Pony.
Pony and Exhibitor to be presented in traditional working harness and attire e.g. Deer Saddle or Panniers, etc. Ponies are to be shown in-hand.

The Winner and Reserve of the D.J. MOLTENO PERPETUAL TROPHY and the Winner and Reserve of the ALFRED BROWN MEMORIAL TROPHY will be required to compete for the OVERALL CHAMPIONSHIP - THE MCLEOD QUAICH
